2	New total triage on-line system introduced on Monday 17 th July New NHS requirement	AJ & IC med students
	Aim to address various healthcare challenges effectively.	
	In the new on-line system, patients' concerns are evaluated by a GP, allowing for a timely determination of how urgent the issue is and appropriate care pathway assignment.	
	Urgent cases are given immediate priority, while less urgent or routine cases may receive advice or could be referred to specialists, streamlining the allocation of healthcare resources and minimising unnecessary visits.	
	The new total triage has replaced a previous on-line booking system with each on- line medical form assessed by a GP and appointment booked as required.	
	To ensure equitable treatment for patients, the access process is divided into three phases:	
	1st. patients provide information through an on-line form or contact the Practice via telephone as they used so the reception team will gather the information and complete the form on patients' behalf,	
	2nd. involves a GP's evaluation for clinical queries, while administrative queries are directly routed to the appropriate team.	
	Challenging start but the system is in full use with a triage team available from 08:00 to 18:00 Monday to Friday. Triage medical and administration teams assessing messages received from patients daily.	
	Phone lines continued to be available from 08:00 to 18:30 weekdays and reception team available to help patients with no access to internet to submit the on-line form on behalf of patient by using a tablet available at the reception.	
	Ability to communicate with patients via short messaging service (AccuRX)
